

### The aim:

Transfer Waypoints including their icons and Info/Comments (visible in MapSource/Basecamp) to the Zumo XT. This seemingly simple task appears impossible, every method has problems!


### 1. USB Import of GPX (using Windows Explorer or Basecamp)

a. Icons aren't retained, they all appear as oversized green hearts on device.


i. MapSource:

b. Info/comment is not accessible on device! A serious problem.

c. Icons only visible when 'Up Ahead Places' is selected (this is less important).


### 2. Explore Website

a. Sometimes import of a GPX containing waypoints will fail if there is a Comment/Info. But this is irrelevant as the info isn't visible in Explore anyway.


b. Icons are still not retained from the GPX:



c. But the icons are decent and a sensible size, and can be allocated within Explore, and transfer to the Device successfully:



- d. Info/comment is not accessible on device, Explore website or Android App (even though you can apparently 'Edit Notes' in the app:




- e. Only the first 20 characters of a Waypoint name are imported:

| Name /                              | S... | Comment    | Position           |
|-------------------------------------|------|------------|--------------------|
| This is a Waypoint with a Long Name |      | Celtic Sea | N51.25392 W3.55818 |



### 3. POI Loader

- a. The Comment/info is accessible! Although for some reason it's duplicated:



- b. Long Waypoint names (20+ characters) are retained.  
c. But, the icons aren't permanently visible on the device's map, they're only visible when searching within Custom POI's.

#### 4. *Conclusion*

The only workaround is to duplicate the information: **Explore** to give visible icons without having to manually create every icon on the device, and **POI's** for the Info/Comment. Which is absurd!
